#### **SCHOOL PAYMENTS**

This year we are promoting the online POP system as our preferred method of payment for all school monies. This is a much safer and secure way of paying money to the school and provides a quick reference for you and the school to check if payment has been made.

POP is accessed through the school website - <a href="https://alfordspt-p.schools.nsw.gov.au/">https://alfordspt-p.schools.nsw.gov.au/</a>

Once in the website you click on Make a Payment on the maroon ribbon and fill in the information with an asterisk (\*). At the bottom you can tick the Other box and fill in what you are paying for. If paying for more than one thing you click on add payment and more boxes appear to fill in. Once you have made

the payment you fill in the permission slip with the receipt number from POP and ask your child to place it in the drop box in front counter box.

With the introduction of LMBR the school now has the facility to accept payment for Fees in Advance. If you would like you can deposit an amount of money at the beginning of the year or Term to be used for any fees that may come up for your child. The permission note still has to be filled out and signed with a note on it saying "Use fees in advance". Some people find this very beneficial.

Of course, you are still able to pay with credit card, cash, cheque or EFTPOS by coming to the front office or placing the payment in the drop box in front counter along with the permission note. If paying by credit card there is a minimum payment of \$15.00. If paying with POP there is no minimum transaction.

When paying for more than one child you can put it in one transaction for the family whether it is POP, Credit Card, Cash, Cheque or EFTPOS


