Student Attendance

Parents/carers are reminded that if your child is away from school we require you to provide an explanation for the absence. This can be done by a telephone call, written note, skoolbag message or email to the school within 7 days from the first day of any period of absence. This applies even if your child is only away for one day.

Safety in Our Playground - Parents In Partnership

Students who arrive to school before 8.30am are to follow very strict procedures in our school playground. No student should be here before 8.20am unless they are attending dance lessons at 8.15am. Our mornings can be very cold and we do have Cindi Kindi that students may attend if parents are committed to work. If your child is here before 8.30am they are to sit on the silver seats outside the canteen/hall until the teacher is on duty. Students are not permitted to play handball or any other game while waiting for the teacher on duty.

After school, at 3.00pm our school playground is not the place to continue games from lunchtime. It is important that everyone, especially students who walk home, leave the playground together at 3.00pm. This is keeping everyone safe as there are lots of people around while students make their way home. Everyone also needs to remember that our school rules do apply to everyone as well. (It is not the time to play with skipping ropes, handballs or soccer balls). All students and pre-schoolers are to stay close to their parents if parents are socialising. If parents are late students need to come to the office.

Your cooperation is sought and greatly appreciated, so that we all maintain a safe, harmonious and happy learning environment for everyone at Alfords Point Public School.
