Mrs Rider, and myself were very proud of all our students as they competed with enthusiasm whilst displaying great sportsmanship.

We had some wonderful results. Congratulations to Zane M 1st 11yrs, Anthony K 4th 8yrs, Lincoln W 4th 10yrs, Aaron H 5th 11yrs and Halle M 4th 11yrs, who placed in their 100m age sprint races. Congratulations to Zane M 2nd 11yrs, Halle M 3rd 11yrs and Aaron H 5th 11yrs in their division of the 200m events. Ali A placed 3rd 11yrs 800m and Lincoln W placed 4th 1500m. Many of our Alfords Point students placed in the top four resulting in them being presented with a prestigious Engadine Zone placegetters ribbon. 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
