Industrial Action

Student Christmas cards

It is that time of year where we traditionally see students bringing Christmas cards with chocolates and candy canes to school. This year we ask that students bring cards and write a lovely message to their friends and leave any food items at home. Our friendly students are always keen to share treats with each other and given the current restrictions, it is best if no food items are shared at school.

Mask wearing at school

Over the past few weeks NSW Health has eased a number of restrictions in the community and the Department of Education has updated some guidelines for NSW Public Schools. Please be aware that the guidelines around adults wearing face masks when entering a school site have not changed.

All Parents/Carers who enter the school site to visit the school office, attend the uniform shop or to drop off and pick up children from Jubilee Alfords Point OOSH Before and After School Care are still required to wear a mask at all times. Student health - Allergies and Anaphylaxis

Parents/Carers are reminded that we have a number of students with health care needs including allergies and anaphylaxis. To keep our school a happy and safe environment for all, we ask our students not to share food and request parents/carers refrain from sending nut products to school as these students are in danger of having an extreme anaphylactic reaction if they are exposed to nuts and nut products of any kind. This is particularly important at the moment. Please be mindful if you are popping treats in your child's lunchbox that they are nut free.

Parents/Carers are advised that the teachers do not hand out birthday cupcakes to other students at recess and lunch. These treats are saved for home time and placed in students' lunchboxes so they can be consumed when the children get home.

I would like to bring your attention to a new Nutella product that is currently being advertised on television. Please be aware this product contains nuts and presents a problem for our Anaphylaxis students if consumed at school. I thank you for your support in reminding your children not to share food at school and being mindful of what you send to school in your child's lunchbox.

Canteen

The canteen will be closed in week 11, December 15 and December 16 for stocktake. Students will need to bring their recess and lunch to school everyday. Please mark these dates in your diary


A Message From Year 6
