Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 Students Easter Hat Parade

Parents/Carers, grandparents, neighbours and friends are warmly invited to attend on the day.

Children in K-2 are encouraged to start making Easter hats ready for the special Easter Hat Parade

We are requesting that the hats be made at home, however, please keep the hats simple as the students only wear them for a short time and the parade is really just to create a special memory in their school life. No prizes are awarded. If you need assistance or ideas please ask your child's class teacher.

The base of the hat could be made from an old hat or from cardboard. Some appropriate decorations could include stickers, ribbons, cotton wool, etc. Real chocolate eggs are not suitable as they could melt. Hot glue guns will ensure decorations do not fall off, however, these are not suitable for children to use themselves due to their extreme heat. (It is recommended hot glue guns be used whilst wearing cotton gloves). Shops such as Spotlight, the Base store and Hot Dollar sell inexpensive Easter decorations. We encourage the use of recycled materials also.

Please bring finished hats to school on the morning of the Parade and place them on the large tables near the sink in your child's classroom. It is a good idea to check before leaving home that all the decorations have stuck on very well so that repairs can be made before the Parade. We will check them also and make any necessary repairs.
