Please complete the permission note below and return to Mrs Burke via the office drop box by Monday 13 February 2023. Included is a list of your child's events and an Engadine Zone PSSA annual swimming carnival draft program.

The cost of hiring a bus to transport our zone squad is excessive. Therefore, students are to travel to the pool by private transport. Please indicate below if you are taking your child on the day and how many other students you can transport. Many parents cannot attend due to work commitments, so we ask that those attending assist with transportation.

If you can transport students, it is a Department of Education requirement that you provide to the front office prior to the event the following documentation:

- declaration for non-child related workers form (please contact the office for a copy of the form if required)
- written permission from the parent of each student travelling
- a current drivers licence
- a current vehicle registration certificate

Parents need to pay a spectator fee of \$2.00 at the pool entrance, if attending the carnival. All students must meet Mrs Rider **inside** the pool by 8.25 am. All schools will be seated on the grassed area with supervising teachers and parents. Students are not permitted to enter the water before the races begin. Students should wear the Alfords Point sports uniform, sun hat and sunscreen, bring a rug/groundsheet, towel and swimming costume, water and food for lunch and snacks.

Again, this year Alfords Point has the responsibility of organising the Zone Carnival. We have done so for the past eleven years, and it is always a huge success. We are asking for parents to volunteer to be a timekeeper for about one hour at the carnival as we need to supply timekeepers all day on one of eight lanes. Please complete the form below stating your time of day preferences to time keep.
